BAE SYSTEMS HUNTER CLASS FRIGATE PROGRAM (HCFP)

BAE Systems was selected in 2018 as the preferred tenderer for the Hunter Class Frigate Program (HCFP) to deliver nine anti-submarine warfare frigates to the Royal Australian Navy. Australian companies are to play a significant role in the prototyping phase with majority of materials and services provided from within Australia. Through ICN Gateway, BAE Systems have listed 163 work packages, receiving 3,833 EOIs and awarded 33 contracts so far.

USFPI NORTHERN TERRITORY TRAINING AREAS & RANGES PROJECT

The NT Training Areas and Ranges Project seeks to upgrade and expand the existing facilities at Robertson Barracks Close Training Area, Kangaroo Flats Training Area, Mt Bundey Training Area; and Bradshaw Field Training Area to support the United States Forces Posture Initiative (USFPI) within the Territory. Through ICN Gateway, Managing Contractor Sitzler, have listed 87 work packages, receiving 4,347 EOIs, and awarded 18 contracts so far.

AIR6500 JOINT BATTLE MANAGEMENT AND INTEGRATED AIR AND MISSILE DEFENCE SYSTEM

The AIR6500 Project is a strategically important program to build and maintain an enduring and regionally superior Australian capability with an opportunity to enter export markets. Lockheed Martin Australia is identifying potential suppliers with the ability to develop, integrate, build, supply and maintain capabilities and elements within Australia and New Zealand. Through ICN Gateway, the project has listed 18 work packages, and has received 1,473 EOIs to date.

LARRAKEYAH DEFENCE PRECINCT REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Larrakeyah Defence Precinct is a critical enabler and provides support to the sustainment of the Australian Defence Force. The base supports numerous Army, Navy and Joint units, including Headquarters Northern Command, North West Mobile Force (NORFORCE) and HMAS Coonawarra. Through ICN Gateway, the project has listed 30 work packages, receiving 938 EOIs, and awarded 25 contracts so far.

DEPLOYABLE INFRASTRUCTURE – SUPPLY CHAIN EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Saab Australia, a subsidiary of the international aerospace and defence company Saab AB, will leverage its global experience and lead role in Deployable Health System, to provide responsive, scalable, and adaptable deployable infrastructure. Saab is therefore engaging with Australian SMEs about opportunities for supply and support of Deployable Infrastructure programs.
